

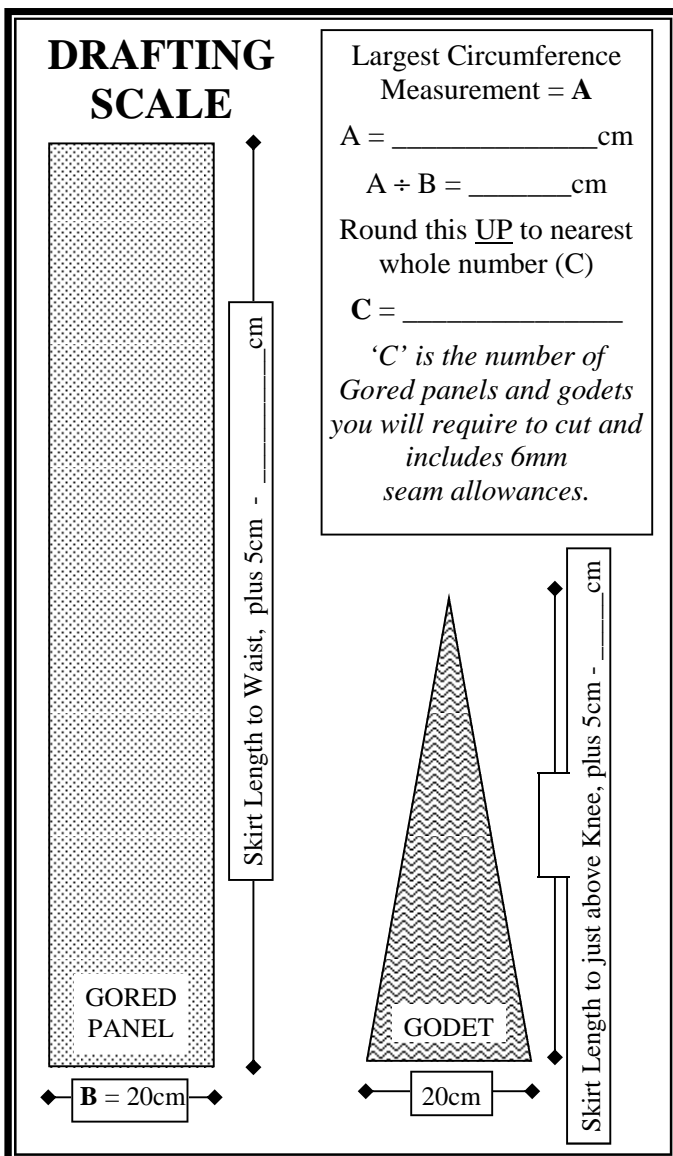
Gored Skirt - Made to Measure

A one day project from Baby Lock Australia

REQUIREMENTS

- 2.5m to 3m stretch fabric-one or two way will work
 - The skinny mini's may have some fabric left for a top also
- 20mm non roll elastic or similar to fit waist
- 4x overlocker thread to match or blend with fabric
 - This will be used for both Overlocking and cover stitch hemming
- Clear foot or Flat Sole Foot to suit machine
- 1m Tracing Fabric
- Tape measure
- Long ruler and biro

METHOD



- Take the measurements required and write them in the appropriate place on the drafting scale
 - Trace out the rectangles and triangles on the Tracing Fabric to the size determined by your measurements
 - From your stretch fabric, cut out the required numbers of rectangles and triangles determined
 - Set your Baby Lock Overlocker up for a four thread stitch and clip on your clear or flat sole foot
 - Stitch a triangle to the long side of each rectangle
 - Stitch each of the sets together, ensuring both the hemline and waistline are lined up
 - Attach the required length of elastic to the waistline using a four thread Overlocking stitch
 - Turn the elastic over and pin in place
 - Set the Overlocker up for a wide Coverstitch and Coverstitch the elastic down
 - Turn up the hem and Coverstitch it to the required length
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
